PREFACE

The 40th edition of Roc d'Azur (hereinafter **the Event**) is organised from the 9th to the 13th of October 2024 by Amaury Sport Organisation (A.S.O.), a French *Société Anonyme* with a share capital of €61,200,240, registered at the RCS de Nanterre under number 383 160 348, and whose headquarters are located in Boulogne-Billancourt Cedex (92650), Bâtiment Quai Ouest, 40-42 quai du point du jour, CS 90302, France (hereinafter the **A.S.O.** or the **Organiser**).

The present document describes:

- (i) the sports rules of the Event (hereinafter the **Rules**),
- (ii) the general terms of sale applicable to any order of products or services relating to the Event made with the Organiser through the intermediary of the registration platform *time to* (hereinafter **A.S.O.'s General Terms of Sale**).

The terms "you", "your" and "yours" refer to you, the participant or consumer and/or his legal representative or legal guardian (over the age of 18) if the participant or consumer is a minor in his country of residence.

Your registration for the Event implies your express and unconditional agreement of these present Rules and A.S.O.'s General Terms of Sale

Only the legal representative of a minor may register this minor for the Event. Therefore, if parental authority is exercised jointly, the minor's legal representative guarantees the Organiser that the other holder of parental authority has read and accepted this document without reservation.

This document completes the Terms of Use for the on-line registration platform known as *time to* (hereinafter **time to**), accessible at the address www.timeto.com/terms-of-use.

In the event of a contradiction between the *time to* Terms of Use, these A.S.O.'s General Terms of Sale, and the Rules, the Rules shall prevail over A.S.O.'s General Terms of Sale, which will in turn prevail over the *time to* Terms of Use.

The Organiser may revise and update A.S.O.'s General Terms of Sale and the Rules at any time; make sure to check them regularly. Any changes which are made apply immediately after notification, through any means including, but not limited to, publication of a revised version hereof on the Event's website www.rocazur.com/en/. In the event of significant changes to the A.S.O.'s General Terms of Sale and/or the Rules, the Organiser will strive to inform you by email at the address provided on *time to*.

N.B.! Role of *time to*:

The *time to* website, through which you placed your order, allows professional sellers and organisers to list and sell their products and services. Although the *time to* platform facilitates the

transactions carried out on it, *time to* is not the seller or organiser of the products and services relating to the Event.

Consequently, for the sale of products or services relating to the Event, a sales contract is formed solely between you and the Organiser. The Organiser is responsible for the sale of products or services relating to the Event and for any claims or other problems arising out of or in connection with the contract of sale between you and the Organiser.

I. SPORTS RULES

These Rules apply to all participants in the Event. They are an integral part of the A.S.O.'s General Terms of Sale mentioned above.

1.1. ROUTES - PROGRAM

The Roc d'Azur is a multi-discipline event covering a range of cycling and outdoor disciplines. It is organised by A.S.O. with the support of Oxygen Sport Association and under the aegis of the Fédération Française de Triathlon (FFTri) for the Tri Roc event, the Fédération Française d'Athlétisme (FFA) for the trail events and the Fédération Française de Cyclisme (FFC) for all the other events.

Compliance with the French Code de la route (Highway Code):

The proposed routes include sections that are open to traffic or may be open to traffic in their entirety.

For everyone's safety and to ensure optimum co-habitation with the other users of these public spaces, it is essential that each participant is particularly vigilant and respects, throughout the route, the French Code de la route (traffic lights, right of way, cycle paths, etc.), the signposting put in place by the Organiser (signposting, tape, signs indicating passages requiring special attention, etc.) as well as the instructions given by the police and by the Organiser's security personnel who may be present at certain intersections/road crossings to facilitate the passage of participants without, however, being in a position to ensure their priority passage.

Route reconnaissance prohibition:

The proposed courses include sections crossing private sites. Crossing agreements have therefore been concluded with their landowners for the 5 days of the Event only and strictly for the number of bibs issued. **For this reason, reconnaissance of the routes is not authorised and in order to avoid clandestine reconnaissance, only the course profiles will be communicated by the Organiser prior to the Event.** Any person on one of the courses who is not in possession of a frame plate corresponding to the event taking place there at the same time will be expelled from the course and disqualified from the event for which they are registered.

1.2. PARTICIPATION CONDITIONS – LICENCE – MEDICAL CERTIFICATE « PARCOURS PREVENTION SANTE »

Checks may be carried out during the Event to ensure that participation is perfectly legal, particularly with regard to age, licence, medical certification or “Parcours Prévention Santé” requirements.

1.2.1. Age categories

The age categories allowed to participate vary according to the events and are indicated on the website of the Event (www.rocazur.com/en).

The existing categories are:

- **Poussin** : 6 to 8 years old / 2016 to 2018
- **Pupille** : 9 and 10 years old / 2014 and 2015
- **Benjamin** : 11 and 12 years old / 2012 and 2013
- **Minime** : 13 and 14 years old / 2010 and 2011
- **Cadet** : 15 and 16 years old / 2008 and 2009
- **Junior** : 17 and 18 years old / 2006 and 2007
- **Espoir** : 19 to 22 years old / 2002 to 2005
- **Sénior** : 23 to 29 years old / 1995 to 2001
- **Master 1** : 30 to 39 years old / 1985 to 1994
- **Master 2** : 40 to 49 years old / 1975 to 1984
- **Master 3** : 50 years old and + / 1974 and before

Only the year of birth is taken into account for the assignment of participants in the categories.

For the Kid events, the age requirements are as follows:

- **Kid Roc Draisiennne (100m)**: open to children born between 2021 and 2022 - No ranking - Takes place at the Base Nature of Fréjus.
- **Kid Roc Mini (150m)**: open to children born between 2019 and 2020 - No ranking - Takes place at the Base Nature of Fréjus.
- **Kid Roc Ruelles de Fréjus (800m)**: open to Benjamins and Minimes (2010 to 2013) - Gives rise to a ranking - Takes place at Place Formigé in Fréjus.
- **Kid Roc Poussins (2Km)**: open to Poussins (2016 to 2018) - Gives rise to a ranking - Takes place at the Base Nature of Fréjus.
- **Kid Roc Pupilles (4Km)**: open to Pupilles (2014 to 2015) - Gives rise to a ranking - Takes place at the the Base Nature of Fréjus.
- **Kid Roc Benjamins (6Km)**: open to Benjamins (2012 to 2013) - Gives rise to a ranking - Takes place at the Base Nature of Fréjus.
- **Kid Roc Minimes (8Km)**: open to Minimes (2010 to 2011) - Gives rise to a ranking - Takes place at the Base Nature of Fréjus.

1.2.2. Licence, medical certificate and “Parcours Prévention Santé”

By participating in the Event, you are taking part in a sporting event approved by the Fédération Française de Cyclisme (hereinafter “FFC”) or by the Fédération Française d’Athlétisme (hereinafter the “FFA”). Consequently, in accordance with the rules laid down by the FFC and by the FFA and followed by the Organiser, your participation is subject to the compulsory presentation of a licence, a medical certificate or a QR Code “Parcours Prévention Santé (hereinafter “QR Code PPS” or “HPC”).

Prior to the Event and by Sunday 22 September 2024 at the latest, you must submit your licence, your medical certificate or your QR Code PPS in electronic format via the download tool accessible on your *time to* account (no documents sent by post or e-mail will be taken into account). If you miss this deadline or if the document has not been validated, you will have to provide these documents when you collect your bib.

Checks on the authenticity of licences, medical certificates and QR Code PPS may be carried out on site, even in cases where the participant has uploaded the document on its *time to* account. Participants must therefore be able to provide these documents when collecting their bib and during the Event.

1.2.2.1. MTB competition / Canyon Gravel Roc

Participation in one of these events is subject to the compulsory presentation of :

- A **FFC (Fédération Française de Cyclisme) licence** valid on the date of the Event **and authorizing the practice of cycling in competition** :
 - o Pass'Cyclisme Open
 - o Pass'Cyclisme
 - o Pass'Cyclo Sportive
 - o Pass sport nature – for mountain bike
- Or one of the following **cycling or cyclo-sport** licences valid on the date of the Event **and authorizing the practice of cycling in competition**:
 - o Fédération Sportive et Culturelle de France (FSCF)
 - o Fédération Sportive et Gymnique du Travail (FSGT)
 - o Union Française des Œuvres Laïques et d'Éducation Physique (UFOLEP)
 - o Fédération Française du Sport Travailleiste (FFST)
- Or a **medical certificate** dating from less than one year before the Event, signed by the doctor, enabling its authentication, written in French, English, Spanish, German, Italian or Portuguese and imperatively bearing the words "**non contre-indication à la pratique du cyclisme en compétition**".

PLEASE NOTE: Holders of a foreign licence, even if it is a competition licence issued by a federation affiliated to the UCI, must provide a **medical certificate** meeting the conditions listed hereinabove.

1.2.2.2. Triathlon

In accordance with the FFTri regulations (article 3.2.1. of the FFTri general regulations) and its insurance policy for participants, all participants must present **(i) a document proving the absence of contraindication to participation in the Event (licence or medical certificate)** and **(ii) must subscribe a "Pass Compétition"**:

- (i) Provisions regarding the documents proving the absence of contraindication to the participation in the Event (licence, medical certificate QR Code PPS)**

Licence:

- **If you are taking part in the entire triathlon**, you may submit one of the following licences valid on the date of the Event:
 - o Licence « Competition » issued by the FFtri

- Licence « Competition » issued by a foreign sport Federation, affiliated to the International Triathlon Union
 - Licence « Competition » issued by the Fédération Française des Clubs de Défense (code 161)
 - Licence « Competition » issued by the Fédération Française du Sport Universitaire
- If you are taking part in the “swimming” portion of the relay, you may also submit one of the following licences valid on the date of the Event:
- Licence « Competition » issued by the Commission Nationale du décathlon moderne
 - Licence « Competition » issued by the Fédération Française de Natation
- If you are taking part in the “cycling” portion of the relay, you may also submit one of the following licences valid on the date of the Event:
- Licence « Competition » issued by the Fédération Française des Clubs de Défense (code 172)
 - Licence « Competition » issued by the Fédération Française de Cyclisme
- If you are taking part in the “running” portion of the relay, you may also submit one of the following licences valid on the date of the Event:
- Licence « Compétition » issued by the Fédération Française des Clubs de Défense (code 172)
 - Licence « Compétition » issued by the Commission Nationale du décathlon moderne
 - Licence « Compétition » issued by the Fédération Française d’Athlétisme

Medical certificate:

If you do not hold one of the licences listed above, you can present a medical certificate dated less than one year before the date of the Event, signed by the doctor, enabling it to be authenticated, drawn up in French, English, Spanish, German, Italian or Portuguese and containing one of the following statements:

- « **Non contre-indication à la pratique du triathlon en compétition** »,
- « **Non contre-indication à la pratique du sport en compétition** »

Or

- “**Non contre-indication à la pratique de la natation en compétition**”, if you only participate in the “swimming” portion of the relay;
- “**Non contre-indication à la pratique du cyclisme en compétition**”, if you only participate in the “cycling” portion of the relay;
- “**Non contre-indication à la pratique de l’athlétisme en compétition**”, if you only participate in the “running” portion of the relay;
- “**Non contre-indication à la pratique du duathlon en compétition**”, if you only participate in the “running” and “cycling” portion of the relay.

QR Code PPS:

You can also present a **QR Code PPS**, dating from less than 3 (three) months before the Event and accessible via the link : <https://pps.athle.fr/?locale=en>.

PLEASE NOTE: With the exception of licence holders with a foreign federation affiliated to the International Triathlon Union, holders of a foreign licence must provide a medical certificate meeting the conditions and containing one of the compulsory statements listed above.

(ii) Special provisions for the subscription to the "Pass Compétition"

In accordance with federal regulations issued by the FFTri, if you do not hold a FFTri Competition licence, you are required to purchase a "Pass Compétition" when you register for the Event on *time to*, in order to be able to participate.

This "Pass Compétition" is a temporary participation permit made compulsory by the FFTri that allows to participate in events approved by the FFTri.

The amount of the "Pass Compétition" is set by the PACA Triathlon League at 8€ if you take part in the entire triathlon and 2€ per discipline for relays, and is paid in full to the PACA Tirathlon League.

The "Pass Compétition" is issued free of charge to members of the following federations:

- Deutsche Triathlon Union e.V.;
- Federazione Italiana Triathlon;
- Federación Española de Triatlón;
- Federação de Triatlo de Portugal;
- Fédération Belge de Triathlon;
- Fédération Luxembourgeoise de Triathlon;
- British Triathlon Federation;
- Dansk Triatlon Forbund;
- Fédération Suisse de Triathlon.

For more information regarding the "Pass Compétition", the Organiser invites you to consult the PACA Triathlon League website.

1.2.2.3. Trail

To take part in a timed trail event, you must present:

- An "**Athlé Compétition**", "**Athlé Entreprise**", "**Athlé running**" or "**Pass EVENT J'AIME COURIR**" licence **issued by the FFA** valid on the date of the Event attesting to the issuance of a medical certificate stating the absence of contraindications to the practice of athletics in competition,
- Or a **medical certificate** dating from less than one year before the Event, signed by the doctor, enabling its authentication, written in French, English, Spanish, German, Italian or Portuguese and **imperatively bearing one of the following statements**:
 - o « non contre-indication à la pratique de l'athlétisme en compétition »,
 - o « non contre-indication à la pratique de la course à pied en compétition »,
 - o « non contre-indication à la pratique du sport en compétition ».
- Or a **QR Code PPS**, dating from less than 3 (three) months before the Event and accessible via the link : <https://pps.athle.fr/?locale=en>.

PLEASE NOTE: Holders of a foreign licence, even if it is a competition licence issued by a federation affiliated to World Athletics, must provide a medical certificate meeting the conditions listed hereinabove.

1.2.2.4. MTB Rando / Electric Rando / Gravel Rando / Walk / Kid Roc Draisienne / Kid Roc Mini / Cyclo Roc

No licence or medical certificate is required for these non-timed events. However, the Organiser draws the attention of the participant or his legal representative, where applicable, to the fact that the participant will have to make efforts that are sometimes intense and/or continuous over the entire distance of the course and that he must remain vigilant in order not to injure himself.

Consequently, the participant or his legal representative guarantees that the participant is in good general health and acknowledges the risks inherent in taking part in one of these events.

1.3. HEALTH PROTOCOL - CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION RELATED TO THE COVID-19 EPIDEMIC

In order to ensure the health safety of participants, the Organiser may issue a health protocol (hereinafter **Health Protocol**) and in particular introduce an obligation of provision of a document proving the participant's non-infection by the COVID-19 virus.

The participant shall strictly comply with the said Health Protocol and acknowledges the Organizer's right to refuse any participant's participation / access to - or to exclude them from - the Event in case of infection by the COVID-19 virus or for non-compliance with the measures enacted, without the Organiser being liable for this reason.

You will be informed of the provisions of this Health Protocol by a communication sent to the e-mail address provided during your registration to the Event on time to.

Regarding the abovementioned document proving the non-infection by the COVID-19 virus issued by the Organiser:

The nature of this required document will be determined by the Organiser, taking into account elements including the requirements of the competent authorities and the state of scientific and technical knowledge, in particular screening, on the day of the Event.

It may in particular consist of a sworn statement of non-infection, a PCR or antigen test results or any other type of test performed within an appropriate time frame prior to the Event, which will be specified.

These Documents contain health data, which will only be viewed / consulted by the competent personnel of the Organiser when collecting the bibs and / or during the Event.

None of this data will be retained by the Organiser.

1.4. BIB COLLECTION

Bibs must be collected by the participants or their legal representatives if applicable, on presentation of the following documents:

- The participant's licence, medical certificate or QR Code PPS (if applicable) meeting the conditions listed hereinabove (only if it has not been submitted and validated beforehand on *time to*),
- The invitation, available to download on *time to* and/or sent by e-mail prior to the Event,
- The participant's valid official identity document.

Bibs may only be collected in the dedicated area of the Event Village (Base Nature François Léotard, 1196 boulevard de la Mer, 83600 Fréjus), on the following dates and times:

- Wednesday 9 October: 11.00am - 7.00pm
- Thursday 10 October: 09.00am - 7.00pm
- Friday 11 October: 09:00am - 7:00pm
- Saturday 12 October: 09:00am - 5:00pm
- Sunday 13 October: no bib collection

No bib will be sent by post.

Bibs may be collected up to 1 hour before the start of events scheduled after 10.00. For events scheduled before this time, bibs must be collected the day before such event.

All allocations of bib is firm and final.

The bib must be placed on the back for cycling events and on the stomach for trail and walking events. The frame plate must be placed on the front of the bike. They will be required for access to the start area and must remain fully legible during the Event, including in bad weather.

1.5. REGISTRATION CONDITIONS AND PRICES

Registrations for the Event will take place exclusively on the *time to* registration platform (www.timeto.com) from 19 February 2024 for pre-registrants and from 21 February 2024 for the general public.

Any person wishing to take part in the Event (or its legal representant if applicable) agrees to register as a member of *time to* beforehand. To this end, this person must complete a *time to* registration form and accept without reservation the *time to* Terms of Use and Privacy Policy. This person undertakes to provide only truthful information relating to his identity.

Any registration for the Event is personal, firm and final, and may not be reimbursed for any reason whatsoever, unless specifically stipulated in the Rules (and in particular in article 1.10 of the Rules).

Each registration entitles to a bib. No transfer of bib is permitted for any reason whatsoever.

Any person transferring its bib to a third party will be held responsible in the event of an accident occurring or caused by the third party during the Event.

The Organiser declines any responsibility in the event of an accident of this type.

When registering as a team, the commitment of team-mates is firm and definitive: team-mates may not be changed.

1.5.1. Bibs

In order to guarantee the quality and safety of the Event, the Organiser reserves the right to limit the number of bibs available for each event.

The price of bibs may vary depending on the date you registration to the Event:

For each event, in the event that the quantities of bibs planned for a prize category (First, Sprint, Endurance and Last Minute) are reached before the date indicated, the rates applicable to the next higher prize category, within the limits of the quantities available, will be applied, regardless of the dates indicated in the previous table.

The price of bibs in this document is expressed in Euros, inclusive of all taxes, at the rate in force on the day of registration.

The Organiser may put in place exceptional promotions to enable you to benefit from a reduction in the price of the bibs.

1.5.2. Travel Services

1.6. CHRONOMETRY AND RANKING – START WAVES – FEEDING POINTS AND ASSISTANCE

1.6.1. Chronometry, ranking and reward

For timed events, timing will be adapted according to the format and constraints of each event.

An electronic chip in the form of a strip will be attached to the bib of each participant in a timed event. This chip will be initialised automatically at the start line and will be used to check the regularity of the race. To ensure normal operation, the chip must not be bent or damaged. A participant who does not follow the course, marked out by the Organiser by human and/or material means, or who crosses the finish line without a chipped frame plate, will not be classified at the finish.

The electronic detection system is selected according to strict reliability criteria. Despite the tests carried out by the manufacturers, there is still a very small percentage of non-detection. The absence of data resulting from this non-detection will not allow the Organiser to include the official or real time of the participant concerned in the classification. The Organiser cannot be held responsible for this.

A ranking will be established for each event, with the exception of the Randos, the Kid Roc Mini and the Kid Roc Draisienne.

These rankings will take into account the categories defined in article 1.2.1 of these Rules and will be specific to each event. Not all categories will be rewarded on the podium (details are available on the Event website).

The rankings for the Roc Trophy, the Rallye Roc, the Enduroc and the Enduroc Electric will be established by adding up the times of each special stage.

The Roc Trophy classification will be established as follows: each day, classification and prize-giving for the day's stage and the general classification.

Any participant starting without having passed the grid control will be considered as not starting and will not be classified.

It is compulsory for the athletes concerned to attend the protocol.

Certain events will entitle participants to rewards, the amounts of which are set out below:

Only athletes licensed with a UCI-affiliated cycling federation are eligible for rewards. To do so, they must indicate their licence number at the time of registration. The total amount of the rewards will be paid by the Organiser to the FFC, which will be solely responsible for paying the rewards to the persons concerned or to their national federation, if they are foreigners, without A.S.O. being held liable in this respect.

The Ford Roc Marathon is part of the UCI calendar as an HC event and, as such, allows UCI points to be awarded according to the following breakdown:

1.6.2. Respect of the start waves

Some starts will be given in waves. Each participant must be at the start of its event at the time indicated on its registration confirmation.

Access to the start waves of the events starting from the Base Nature François Léotard in Fréjus will be via gates where the bibs authorised to access the start line will be announced.

For the "Roc d'Azur" event of the Event, only the distinctive jerseys of the international (World, European) and national Champions awarded by the UCI and the national federations will be allowed on the 1st start wave.

The Organiser has authorised all members of the organisation (volunteers, A.S.O. employees, etc.) present in the start area to ensure that the start waves allocated to each rider are respected. Any participant who refuses to enter the start wave (or a higher wave, at the Organiser's discretion) allocated to him may be subject to time penalties or excluded from the Event.

1.6.3. Feeding points and assistance

Each participant will have access to the feeding points set up for the event for which they have registered.

When leaving a feeding point, each participant must ensure that he has enough water and food to reach the next feeding point.

No following vehicles are permitted. Personal assistance is strictly limited to the feeding points. It is strictly forbidden to change cycles or wheels during the event. Technical assistance is authorised between participants, except for the Tri Roc event.

For each event of the Event, it is the responsibility of each participant to stop and alert in the event of another participant falling.

For the EnduRoc only, any participant who helps another participant during a special must make himself known at the finish of the special. He will then be allowed to restart the special.

1.7. GENERAL SERVICES

Security for the Event, including road safety, is provided by the Préfecture de Police.

The medical service is provided by the Service départemental d'incendie et de secours du Var (83), which may decide to exclude a participant from the Event for medical reasons. By taking part in the Event, you authorise any doctor to carry out or have carried out any medical and/or surgical intervention in the event of an emergency and/or to prescribe any treatment made necessary by the condition of the participant in the event of an incident.

Under no circumstances shall the Organiser be held liable for any participant who is unable to finish the course as a result of a decision taken by its general services.

1.8. ACCES TO THE SITE AND SECURITY

The introduction onto the Event site of any object likely to be dangerous or illegal, in particular drugs, firearms, blunt objects and explosive materials, is strictly forbidden.

In order to gain access to the Event site and to be able to take part in the Event, the participant expressly acknowledges and accepts that security personnel are authorised by the Organiser to control persons and their personal belongings and agrees to submit to this, failing which he will not be authorised to access to the Event site or to be able to take part in the Event.

The Organiser and the security staff are entitled to refuse access to or continuation of the Event to participants who do not comply with the provisions of these Rules or whose behaviour is likely to damage the image of the Event or disrupt its smooth running, in particular and without limitation: fraudulent behaviour at the time of the sale of bibs, introduction of any object which could potentially hinder in any way whatsoever the progress of the Event, traffic and/or the safety of other participants; introduction of any distinctive sign promoting, in any form whatsoever, a political, philosophical or religious opinion likely to damage the image of the Event or disrupt its smooth running; abnormal, inappropriate or amoral behaviour by the participant, particularly if the latter appears to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

1.9. RETIREMENTS AND TIME LIMITS

Except in the case of injury, any participant wishing to retire from the Event must, as far as possible, contact the person in charge at one of the repatriation points set up by the Organiser, who will permanently invalidate its bib. Means of repatriation for participants having retired and bicycles will be set up in each of these zones.

In order to ensure the safety of the participants and to enable the reopening of the roads to motor traffic to be planned, it is essential that participants do not exceed the time limits for the end of each of the events. Any participant exceeding this maximum time or being overtaken by the end-of-event system (made up of the Organiser's vehicles) will be disqualified and will then have to travel under his own responsibility, without any form of assistance from the Organiser (medical assistance, refreshments, etc.) and in compliance with the traffic regulations of the French Code de la route (Highway Code).

Time barriers at the repatriation points will be determined, communicated to participants (via the Event website) and put in place. These time barriers will correspond to the times from which it will no longer be possible to leave the location indicated.

If the participant does not leave the repatriation points before the set time, he will be disqualified and will not appear in the event rankings. Means of transporting participants and bikes will be set up in each of these zones.

On the Tri Roc, all participants must have reached the transition zone between the mountain bike and the run (T2) no later than 4 hours after the start. After this time, participants will not be allowed to start on the run course. The chief referee will be able to modify this elimination time.

1.10. INSURANCES

Civil liability: In accordance with current legislation, the Organiser has taken out an insurance covering the financial consequences of its civil liability, that of its employees and that of all participants in the Event. With regard to the civil liability of the participants, the intervention of this insurance for the latter is limited to accidents that they may cause during the Event.

This cover will be provided in addition to, or in the absence of, any other insurance from which the participants may benefit. Proof of insurance cover can be provided to any participant on request.

Cancellation insurance: All participants in the Event may take out a cancellation insurance when they register for the Event on *time to*, the details of which can be consulted on the Event website (<https://www.rocazur.com/en/>, in the Registration / Register / Insurances section) or at the following address: <https://www.aso.sam-assurance.com/rocdazur>. This option must be taken out

before the order is validated and enables you to be reimbursed for all or part of the price of your bib, subject to compliance with the conditions described in the aforementioned notice.

Individual accident: All participants in the Event, whether or not they are members of a sports federation, can take out, when they register for the Event, or at the latest when they collect their bib, an insurance guaranteeing the payment of a lump sum in the event of bodily injury (death or permanent disability) due to an accident occurring on the course of the Event. Compensation, depending on the damage and the cover limits chosen, is paid if the insured person is the victim of an accident while taking part in the Event.

THIS INSURANCE IS OPTIONAL BUT STRONGLY RECOMMENDED. It may be taken out in addition to, or as an alternative to, insurance of the same type held in particular via a sports licence.

Such insurance can be taken out, at the time of registration, with the insurer of your choice or with the broker MARSH, whose offers can be found here: <https://aso.sam-assurance.com/rocdazur>. If you have any further questions, please contact Marsh (relationclient.aso@sam-assurance.com).

Material damage: The Organiser declines all liability in the event of damage (theft, breakage, loss, etc.) to participants' personal property, even if the Organiser is responsible for its supervision. This applies in particular to any damage suffered by the participant's personal belongings while they are left in any lockers set up by the Organiser during the Event. Participants may not claim against the Organiser for any theft of or damage to their equipment. It is the responsibility of each participant to take out insurance to cover these risks.

1.11. USE OF IMAGES

1.11.1. Participant's image

As the Event may be captured for the purposes of communication to the public, in any form (in particular photo, video, drawing, etc.), on any existing or future medium (posters, flyers, web banners, etc.), on any existing or future communication channel (official website of the Event, official pages of the Event on Twitter, Facebook, Instagram, etc.), in any format, throughout the world, for any use including advertising and/or commercial purposes, you expressly authorise the Organiser, its successors in title or assigns (in particular its commercial partners) to record and display, on any medium and by any means, and consequently, to reproduce and represent, without remuneration or compensation of any kind, the name, voice, image, and more generally the sporting performance of the participant in the context of the Event (hereinafter referred to as his **Image**), for a period not exceeding 10 (ten) years following the date of the Event. In this respect, you expressly authorise the Organiser to grant sub-licences to the Event's partners to use the Image for advertising and/or commercial purposes.

To this end, you expressly and irrevocably authorise the Organiser, its successors in title or assigns (in particular its commercial partners), in order to meet the requirements of advertising, promotional and/or commercial campaigns, to :

- make any modification, addition or deletion that it deems useful for the exploitation of the Image under the conditions defined above,
- associate and/or combine with the Image any/all signatures, catchphrases, slogans, captions, trademarks, distinctive signs, legal notices, visuals and, in general, any element of any nature of their choice intended in particular to illustrate the communication media in which it is integrated.

You guarantee that the participant is not bound by any exclusive contract relating to the use of his Image.

You are informed and accept without reservation that participation in the Event implies the capture of the Image by the Organiser's official service providers. The Image reproduced in photo and/or video format will be accessible on the time to website in the "My Account" section and for one (1) year on the Event website in the "Results" section and, where applicable, on the website of A.S.O.'s photo and/or video service provider. With regard to the Event website, you accept that the participant may be identified by any internet user entering his surname, first name and/or bib.

If you wish to object to such publication, you may make a request to the Organiser at rocatur@aso.fr, prior to the Event and no later than 30 (thirty) days before the Event, so that the appropriate measures can be taken.

1.11.2. Images of the Event

Any communication of still images and/or animated sequences of the Event, by the participant, captured during his participation in the Event, must be limited to personal use and may under no circumstances be used for promotional and/or commercial purposes outside of the Event.

1.12. PERSONAL DATA

Generally speaking, the personal data communicated when the participant registers for the Event (hereinafter referred to as the **Data**) is intended for the authorised personnel of the Organiser, which is the company responsible for processing this data.

To find out about the Organiser's data protection policy, the Organiser invites you to refer to the A.S.O.'s General Terms of Sale.

At the end of the Event, information relating to the participant's sporting performance (in particular his result, photos and videos) are published on the Event website and, where applicable, the website of A.S.O.'s photo and/or video service provider.

If you wish to object to such publication on the Event website or on the website of A.S.O.'s photo and/or video service provider, you may request that your Data be made anonymous by exercising your right to be forgotten at any time by filling in the "RGPD Rights" form provided on the Event website. The Organiser will reply within the legal time limit of 30 (thirty) days if your request is complete.

Any publication of the results by a media outlet constitutes the processing of Data for information purposes, and as such constitutes a derogation from Data protection. However, if you wish your results to be dereferenced by any third party site, A.S.O. cannot act as an intermediary. We invite you to contact the media concerned in order to make any request relating to your rights.

Data retention period

The Data is kept for a period of 3 (three) years from the end of the Event. At the end of this retention period, and for limited reasons authorised by law (payment, guarantee, disputes, etc.) or any other purpose specified in A.S.O.'s General Terms of Sale, A.S.O. will temporarily archive the Data in a secure digital safe located in France. Only duly authorised A.S.O. personnel will be able to access it

for the period of time required by law depending on the type of Data and the purpose of the archiving. After this legal period, A.S.O. will delete the Data permanently and securely.

Health Data

The Organiser will not keep any health data that may be requested by the Organiser under the conditions set out in article 1.3. of the Rules.

1.13. Aerial filming

The Organiser hereby informs you that :

- on the day of the Event, remotely piloted aircraft (drones) may be used for filming purposes;
- during all or part of their participation in the Event, participants may be less than thirty (30) metres from said aircraft.

Where applicable, safety instructions will be communicated to them and must be complied with.

1.14. RESPECT FOR THE ENVIRONMENT

In order to respect the environment and the natural areas crossed, it is strictly forbidden to leave rubbish (paper, plastic packaging, etc.) on the course. Rubbish bins, and where appropriate selective sorting bins, will be available at each feeding points and "collection zones" will be set up and signposted at various points along the route. They must be used by Participants.

Participants must keep their rubbish and packaging until the places indicated by the Organiser have been found to dispose of it.

The Organiser reserves the right to award time penalties or exclude from the Event participants who deliberately dispose of their waste outside the designated areas.

1.15. MANDATORY, AUTHORISED, RECOMMENDED AND ORIHIBITED EQUIPMENT

The bicycles admitted must comply with the official standards in force, as defined by the FFC and the UCI and specified on the Event's website. Competitors are solely responsible for ensuring that the equipment they use complies with current standards, as well as for its maintenance.

Each participant must present himself at the start of his event with his helmet on his head and the chinstrap fastened, and must keep it on throughout the event.

If the compulsory equipment is not present at the start, the competitor will not be allowed to take part in the event. If the compulsory equipment is not worn during the event, the competitor may be excluded from the Event or given a time penalty.

In the event of non-compliance with the wearing of compulsory equipment, the Organiser cannot be held responsible for any incidents or their consequences.

Special provisions:

- **Electrically-assisted mountain bikes** are only accepted in events marked "ELECTRIC". The use of an electric bike in an event not corresponding to these criteria will result in the exclusion of the participant from the Event.
- **Tri Roc:** movement within the transition area, before or during the event, will only be permitted on foot, with the bike in hand. Audio devices (such as iPods) are totally forbidden during the event.
- **Gravel Roc:** participants in the Gravel Roc must take part in this event on a Cyclo-Cross or Gravel-type bike. Road handlebars are compulsory. Mountain bikes are strictly forbidden. Anyone taking part in this event with a mountain bike will be disqualified and excluded from the Event.

1.16. ANTI-DOPING

The Event is organised under the aegis of the FFC, the FFA and the FFtri. As such, anti-doping tests may be carried out during the Event. Participants undertake to comply strictly with the ban on doping as well as the provisions concerning anti-doping tests, as they result from the laws and regulations in force, in particular articles L. 230-1 et seq. of the French Sports Code.

Any refusal to submit to a doping test or any positive test will be the subject of disciplinary proceedings before the federation with which the participant has a licence or before the French Anti-Doping Agency, if the participant does not have a licence with any federation. The participant will also be excluded from the Event.

1.17. MODIFICATION – REPORT – INTERRUPTION – CANCELLATION

If circumstances so require, the Organiser reserves the right to modify the route, the position of feeding points and chronometry points at any time, to postpone the date and/or times of the Event, to stop the Event in progress, to cancel it or to set up an alternative route without being held liable in this respect.

1.17.1. Cancellation / postponement of the Event for any reason related to COVID-19

If the Event has to be postponed and/or cancelled by the Organiser for any reason related to the COVID-19 health crisis, the Organiser will offer you a refund of the sums paid at the time of your registration, less, where applicable, the amount of the options subscribed to which you could benefit independently of the holding of the Event.

1.17.2. Cancellation / postponement of the Event for any reason other than COVID-19

If the Event has to be cancelled for any reason beyond the control of the Organiser other than those related to the COVID-19 health crisis, the latter may offer, depending on the circumstances, compensation such as substitution by another event organised by the Organiser, postponement of the Event or reimbursement of the price of the race number, to the exclusion of any other sum.

II. A.S.O.'S GENERAL TERMS OF SALE

If you have ordered, whether in return for payment or free of charge, an "ROC D'AZUR " product or service from the Organiser via the time to registration platform, then these A.S.O. General Terms and Conditions of Sale apply to you and constitute the sales contract between you and the Organiser.

2.1. FIELD OF APPLICATION

A.S.O.'s General Terms of Sale are not applicable to the goods and services that you have acquired, by any means whatsoever, from third parties, whether these third parties be appointed or licensed by the Organiser or not. The products and services covered by A.S.O.'s General Terms of Sale are only those provided directly by the Organiser and ordered via *time to*.

2.2. PRICES

Offers of products and services are valid as long as they are visible on the www.timeto.com site. The prices displayed exclude postage and packaging costs and any other specific services that you may have signed up for.

The price of the race numbers are given in the Rules. The Organiser reserves the right to organise special offers outside the price brackets, establishing special rates for a given period.

The prices of products and services is given in euros, including all taxes, at the rate applicable on the day of the order. The prices do not include postage costs, gift wrapping, any special offers and personal reductions ("promotional codes") given before the final approval of the order.

The prices consider French VAT applicable on the day of the order and any changes in the legal VAT rate will automatically be reflected in the product prices displayed on *time to*. However, prices cannot be modified once the user's order has been placed.

Orders destined for countries outside the European Union are not subject to French VAT. The prices displayed on *time to* for these orders, therefore, do not include tax. 2.4. CONDITIONS FOR PLACING AN ORDER

Orders can be placed exclusively with *time to* at www.timeto.com.

No order sent by email or by post will be processed by the Organiser.

When you place your order on *time to*, you must create a *time to* account and, as such, you must accept the *time to* Terms of Use and Confidentiality Policy.

You must confirm your order after selecting the products added to your basket. Before confirming your order, you must check the contents of your basket (identification and quantity of products and services) before validating them and accepting these A.S.O. General Terms and Conditions of Sale and the Regulations.

The Organiser will confirm receipt of your order by sending you an order confirmation email including an order summary and your payment receipt.

2.5. PAYMENT METHODS

Other than in exceptional circumstances, only on-line payments by bank card using the *time to* registration form are authorised.

Online payments to *time to* are made cash and via a secure payment platform, which has specific control measures in order to guarantee the security of purchases made on *time to* and to combat fraud.

The details of your bank card you provide when you place your order will never be communicated unencrypted on the internet network: they are encrypted using an SSL security protocol.

2.6. SENDING AND DELIVERY OF PRODUCTS AND SERVICES

With the exception of Event race numbers which must be collected in line with the terms defined in these Rules, products and services offered may be delivered according to price conditions given at the time of your order.

2.7. RIGHT TO CANCEL

2.7.1. Purchase of leisure services or personalised products

The term 'leisure services' refers to purchasing race numbers, catering tickets, etc. You have no right to cancel the purchase of personalised products or the purchase of leisure services which must be provided on a date or according to a specific time period, in line with legal provisions set out in Article L.221-28 and following of the French Consumer Code as follows:

3 ° Contract supplying of goods made to the consumer's specifications or clearly personalized

12 ° Contract providing accommodation services, other than residential accommodation, goods transport services, car rental, catering or leisure activities that must be provided at a specified date or period; "

2.7.2. Purchase of non-personalised merchandising products and other articles

In line with the legal provisions in force, you have, for non-personalised merchandising, a period of fourteen (14) days from receiving or collecting the merchandising product sold by the Organiser to

Refund in the event of cancellation

In the event that you exercise your right to cancel and obtain a refund within the time periods mentioned above, only the price of the product(s) bought and postage costs will be refunded. The price of returning the goods is at your own cost. The products must be returned intact, in perfect resale condition and in their original packaging. Articles which are returned incomplete, damaged, or soiled by the user/consumer will not be accepted or refunded. You must include a copy of your receipt with your return.

If you exercise your right to cancel, the Organiser will proceed to refund the amounts paid (including delivery costs) no later than fourteen (14) days after the date on which A.S.O. is informed of the decision by the user/consumer to cancel. The date of refund may be delayed until the products are returned or until you have provided proof of the products being sent, the date of the first of these being the date used.

The refund will be made using the same payment method that was used for the order.

The Organiser is not bound to refund additional costs if you specifically chose a delivery method which is more expensive than the standard delivery on offer.

In the event of abnormal or abusive returns, the Organiser reserves the right to refuse any later orders.

2.8. PRODUCT CONFORMITY AND LEGAL GUARANTEE

For products that you have bought from the Organiser and via time to, the Organiser is liable for defects in the conformity of the product, covered by the contract, under the terms of Article L.217-3 and following of the French Consumer Code and any hidden defects of the item sold under the terms set out in Articles 1641 and following of the French Civil Code. In terms of the warranty against hidden defects, you may decide to implement this warranty in the sense of Article 1641 of the French Civil Code.

Please note: For products bought from third parties, such as the photo pack, you must contact the seller in question to exercise your rights. The Organiser cannot act as a substitute for the vendor.

2.9. RESPONSABILITY - FORCE MAJEURE

The Organiser agrees to describe the services and products offered on the *time to* site as accurately as possible. However, the Organiser's may not be held liable in the event that it is unable to implement its obligations due to an unpredictable and insurmountable event act by a third party to the contract or in the event of force majeure as defined by Article 1218 of the French Civil Code and by French jurisprudence. Similarly, the Organiser may not be held liable for any inconvenience or damage inherent in the use of the internet, particularly due to a lack of service, external intrusion or the presence of computer viruses.

2.10. PERSONAL DATA

These partners have agreed to maintain the confidentiality, security and integrity of the Data.

The Data are hosted outside the European Union, in the United States.

You may receive telephone calls and/or letters, emails or text messages regarding special offers from commercial partners of the Organiser, to whom the Data may be communicated and sold for commercial purposes, on the condition that you have checked the box to this effect when you order on *time to*. In any case, participants may oppose this in your "My Account" area or according to the terms set out below.

Pursuant to the Law of 6 January 1978 on Data Protection and Freedom of Information, you have the right to query, access, rectify and oppose for legitimate reasons all the Data which concerns you as well as the right to oppose commercial marketing from the Organiser and/or its commercial partners. You also have the right to create specific or general directives about the retention, removal and communication of your Data after your death.
